Hsu-Shih Shih is an Emeritus Professor in the Department of Management Sciences at Tamkang University, Taiwan, R.O.C. He earned his Ph.D. in Industrial and Manufacturing Systems Engineering from Kansas State University, Manhattan, U.S.A., in 1995. He also holds an MS in Mechanical Engineering from Chung Cheng Institute of Technology, Taiwan (1984), and a BS in Naval Architecture and Marine Engineering from the same institution (1978). He has been a visiting scholar at the University of Pittsburgh, U.S.A. (2007), Aalto University, Finland (2010), and the Norwegian School of Economics, Norway (2014). His areas of specialization include decision analysis and support, operations research, soft computing, and environmental management. His publications appear in prestigious journals such as the European Journal of Operational Research, Computers and Operations Research, the Journal of Operational Research Society, and the Journal of Cleaner Production, among others. He has authored four book chapters and three books published by Springer Nature. Shih has held several leadership roles in the Operations Research Society of Taiwan and INFORMS Taiwan Chapter, including Secretary (2012-13), Council Member (2014-15), President (2016-17), and Supervisor (2018-19). He also served on the executive committee of the International Society on Multiple Criteria Decision Making (2017-22). In 2022-25, he was recognized on Stanford/Elsevier's Top 2% Most Influential Scientists list globally.
